Federalist Ideology

- 1.The party favored centralization, federalism, modernization and protectionism.
- 2.The Federalists called for a strong national government that promoted economic growth and fostered friendly relationships with Great Britain in opposition to Revolutionary France.

Anti-Federalist Ideology

- 1.Many Anti-Federalists preferred a weak central government because they equated a strong government with British tyranny.
- 2.They felt that the states were giving up too much power to the new federal government.

Over the decade of the 1790s, the Federalists stood for the following economic policies: funding of the old Revolutionary War debt and the assumption of state debts, passage of excise laws, creation of a central bank, maintenance of a tariff system, and favourable treatment of American shipping.

Anti-Federalist denied that state economic policies were bad or that economic conditions were disastrous.

In ancient China, the centralized system of absolute monarchy was used to manage the country.
